



What is CVEC?


The CVEC fee is collected by the CROUS to promote the welcoming and social, health, cultural and sports support of all students. It's also collected to reinforce the actions of prevention and health education. It costs €95, and it's mandatory for all students.

CVEC's payment is one of the mandatory things for your registration in your University in France. You need to <u>sign up here</u> and then <u>go right here</u> to process the payment of that fee.


How to complete to CVEC process?

Students meeting certain criteria are not required to pay for the CVEC. Keep reading to find out if it is your case!



Who is exempted from CVEC's payment?

There are 4 types of students who can be exempted from CVEC's payment:

- You're an Erasmus student (part of the exchange program)
- You benefit from the CROUS / BGF (French government) / Campus France scholarship
- You benefit from subsidiary aid or specific aid
- You have refugee status or you are registered as an asylum seeker who has a right to remain in the country.

For the year 2022-2023, the refund application campaign is open until May 31, 2023. And to get the refund, you just have to go to the CVEC website.
